

## The Book of 2<sup>nd</sup> KINGS

1 & 2 Samuel The Judge/Prophet Samuel provides transition from Judges to Prophets  
Saul is the first King, followed by David

1 & 2 Kings is the history of: the Kings of Israel, the Northern Kingdom and  
the Kings of Judah, the Southern Kingdom

1 & 2 Chronicles is the history of only the Kings of Judah

19 Kings of Israel came from 9 different families.

20 Kings of Judah came from 1 line of Kings, the Linage of David

### THE MIRACLES OF ELISHA IN 2 KINGS

- 2:14 Parted the water
- 2:21 Made bad water good by throwing in salt
- 2:24 Made 2 bears maul 42 boys for mocking the work of God in town and the man of God. (possible a gang of teenagers)
- 3:16-19 Water from a dry stream bed to defeat the Moabites
- 4:3-7 Filling all the jars from one jar of oil
- 4:14-16 Shunammite woman has a son
- 4:34-36 Raises the Shunammite's son from dead
- 4:41 Cleansed a pot of poison food
- 4:43-44 Multiplied bread so 100 men could eat
- 5:10-14 Naaman Cleansed from leprosy
- 5:25-27 Elisha's servant Gehazi cursed with leprosy
- 6:6-7 The Floating ax head
- 6:11-12 Tells the King of Israel what the King of Syria "speaks in his bedroom"
- 6:17 Caused his servant to see the chariots of fire
- 6:18-20 Blinded the Syrian army that had come to capture him
- 7:1-2, 6-7 Caused a noise that caused the Syrians to flee in the night
- 8:10-12 Told Hazeal he would be King of Syria, then wept because he saw the evil of Hazeal
- 13:14-20 Death of Elisha
- 17:5-8 722 BC Samaria falls to Assyria, Israel carried away captive never to be a kingdom again**
