

# The FIFTH Book of Moses called DEUTERONOMY

Deuteronomy 7:7-8

Hebrew Title "These are the words"  
Greek- "deuteros"- second "nomos or nomion" – law

not a new law but repeated to a new generation  
Pentateuch (means 5) The Torah Book of Moses

Rabbinic writings date is at 1312 BC

Considered final by 445 BC when Ezra returned from Babylonian Exile with the Book of Moses 3:2 7:6

Jesus: Luke 24:44

Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." NKJV

**THE BASIC FACT Deut 6:4-9** 4 "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 6 "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

#### **THE BASIC TRUTH Deut 6:23-25**

23 Then He brought us out from there, that He might bring us in, to give us the land of which He swore to our fathers. 24 And the Lord commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the Lord our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is this day.
