Name means: Jehovah is God, The Lord is God

Date: Unknown There is no mention of a king. Possibly early date of 837-830 BC when Joash was 7 years old and to young to be king.

OR, 400 BC Post-Exilic. Jerusalem is mentioned but not Israel. Joel is a prophet to Judah, the restored, united Israel. The Northern Kingdom no longer exists. 3:6 refers to the Greeks. Greeks were known but became the world power when they destroyed the Persian empire in 331 BC.

It was a time when no king is mentioned and the priests were in charge.
